




Grammar Architect

Meanwhile, the womans father -- a personified version of the tragedy that hangs over all Hardy novels -develops a taste for destruction and decides to stick it to everyone. Soon, as copies of the book start turning up everywhere from the Australian outback to the wreck of the Titanic, the mans genius is suddenly called into question.
